The Every Child, Every Day Academy Trust was set up on the 1st September 2016 and is a charitable trust and an exempt charity. At present it consists of 2 secondary schools; Grey Court and Hollyfield.

The purpose of the Trust, working through partnership and collaboration, is to maintain and strengthen good and outstanding schools, and to ensure the rapid improvement of schools which need support now (and in the future). It is also to act as a vehicle for enabling the sharing of best practice and achieving economies of scale across the group of academies.

The Trust will act as the lead sponsor for any school that wishes to become an academy or for schools which are being directed to become sponsored academies by the Department for Education. This is dependent on their meeting our rigorous due diligence requirements and on both parties, the regional schools' commissioner and the academy's brokers believing that it is in their best interests to join.
