Maths: Arithmetic test to be looked over and practised for a similar test next Wednesday.

Maths target for the week:

- 1. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 7, 8 9 and 10, extending to 20.
- 2. To add and subtract one-digit and 2-digit numbers to 30, including 0.

This week we have introduced the children to dines to show how a 2-digit number is made up of so many tens and some ones.

Please reinforce this learning by encouraging your children to use money (IOp and Ip coins) to make up 2-digit numbers and adding simple sums up to 20p.

You could further challenge by asking them to take away sums using pennies.
