Spellings practise: Look say, cover, write, check.

This week we have looked at adding **–s** and **–es** to make plurals of nouns. The common reading words for this week are: **called, didn't** and **other**.

Please practise these with your child at least 3 times a week.

Maths target for the week:

1. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 5, 6 and 10.

2. To understand doubles and halves. Try these:

Double: $3 (3 + 3) = 6$

$$6 (\quad + \quad) = \quad$$

$$8 (\quad + \quad) = \quad$$

Halve: $4 (\text{split into 2 equal groups}) = 2$

$$8 (\text{halve}) = \quad$$

$$12 (\text{halve}) = \quad$$

3. To solve problems involving multiplication and division. Try these:

I buy 5 stamps. Each stamp costs 5p. How much do they cost altogether? Draw a picture to work it out.

Share 10 oranges between 5 children. How many oranges does each child get?
