Maths target for the week:

1. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 7, 8 9 and 10, extending to 20 and 100 (in multiples of 10).
2. To understand doubles and halves. Try these:

Double:  $3 (3 + 3) = 6$

$$7 ( \quad + \quad ) = \quad$$

$$11 ( \quad + \quad ) = \quad$$

Halve:  $4 (\text{split into 2 equal groups}) = 2$

$$12 (\text{halve}) = \quad$$

$$16 (\text{halve}) = \quad$$

3. To solve problems involving multiplication and division. Try these:

I buy 5 stamps. Each stamp costs 10p. How much do they cost altogether? Draw a picture to work it out.

Jon and his two brothers are given £9 to share. How much will each of them get?
