Maths: Arithmetic test to be looked over and practised for a similar test next Wednesday.

Maths target for the week:

- 1. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 7, 8 9 and 10.
- 2. Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs. (understand that numbers get smaller when taking away and that they get bigger when adding)
- 3. Write number sentences
- 4. Recognise odd and even numbers

For example: Which four number sentences link these 3 numbers?

$$1 + 5$$

Answer: $1 + 4 = 5$, $4 + 1 = 5$, $5 - 1 = 4$ and $5 - 4 = 1$

There are 5 counters. How can you put them in 3 groups making sure each group has an odd number of counters?
