Maths: Arithmetic test to be looked over and practised for a similar test next Wednesday.

Maths target for the week:

- I. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 5, 6 and 10.
- 2. Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems. For example:

James has two dice.

He rolls them and scores 5 altogether.

Which two numbers could he have rolled?

3. Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes, including rectangles, squares, circles and triangles, cuboids, pyramids and spheres.

Please encourage children to look around and find these shapes in common everyday objects.
