Maths: Arithmetic test to be looked over and practised for a similar test next Wednesday.

Maths target for the week:

- 1. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 7, 8 9 and 10, extending to 20.
- 2. Tell the time to hour and half past and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. Please reinforce this learning by relating to activities they do in real time For example, get up at 7 o'clock, have breakfast at half past 7, get ready for school at 8 o'clock, and so on.

Extend their learning through problems like: Ben leaves for school at half past 8. His brother leaves for college half an hour later. What time would that be? Can you draw a clock face and show that time using the hands on the clock?
