Spellings practise: Look say, cover, write, check.

This week we have looked at alternative spellings for the *-ee* (*ea, e-a, e-e, ie, ey, y*) phoneme. The common reading words for this week are: *people*, and *new*.

Please practise these with your child at least 3 times a week.

Please practise reading these words (some real and some alien) with your child, making sure they recognise every phoneme (single sound) in it.

This exercise is in preparation for the phonics screening check that takes place later this year.

Maths: Arithmetic test to be looked over and practised for a similar test next Wednesday.

Maths target for the week:

1. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 5, 6 and 10.
2. Measure and begin to record lengths and heights.

Please reinforce this learning by encouraging your children to use the language of comparison – longer than, shorter than, faster, slower...

You could further challenge by asking them to estimate in centimetres, then actually measuring using a ruler or tape and see what the difference was. Ensure they start at 0.
