Maths target for the week: Number bonds

1. Continue to practise rapid recall number bonds to 7, 8 and 9, extending to 20 and 100 (in multiples of 10).
2. To recognise and find halves and quarters of objects, shapes and quantities.

Find half of these numbers: Use your knowledge of tens and ones to help divide into 2 equal parts.

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 18 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

3. Draw a picture to show $\frac{1}{4}$ of 24. How many equal parts will you need? How many in one part?
