$12 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$

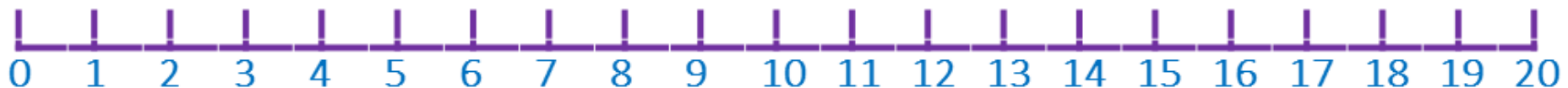
$9 + 8 = \underline{\quad}$

$19 - 15 = \underline{\quad}$



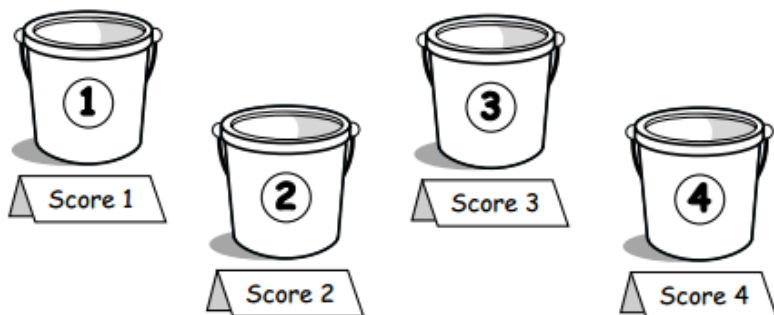
Challenge:
