Spellings to be learnt for a test on Monday.

Spelling rule = using hyphens

Hyphens can be used to join a prefix to a root word, especially if the prefix ends in a vowel letter and the root word also begins with one e.g. co-own, de-ice

They are also used when writing numbers e.g. seventy-eight and for ages if written before the noun e.g. 'The eleven-year-old girl' but not if the age is after the noun e.g. 'The girl is eleven years old.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud as you write it e.g. 'co-operate, c ... o ... - ... o ... p ... e ... r ... a ... t ... e'
