When a word ends in a silent e, keep the e... if the suffix begins with a consonant

hope — hopeful

Rule 4

When a word ends in ee or ge, keep the e if the suffix begins with a or o

notice — noticeable advantage — advantageous

Rule 5

When a word ends in y change it to i except when the suffix is ing

baby — babies cry — crying

Rule 6

When a word ends in a vowel before the y... keep the

boy — boys enjoy — enjoyment
