This week we have continued to learn the conventions for adding the suffix 'ing' for the present tense. We have investigated how the root word sometimes changes when adding 'ing'.

Three of the rules are:

- Do nothing (when there are two consonants at the end)
- Drop the e (when a verb ends in e)
- Double the final consonant (when a verb ends in a single vowel and a single consonant)

Look carefully at these verbs. Can you sort them into groups using the three rules above?

live	stop	walk
bark	bake	come
run	hop	fill
make	kiss	chat
busk	take	beg

Can you convert the verbs into the continuous present tense using the rules?
