

Spelling and Grammar Home Learning – 24.02.17

This week we have been revising the rules for adding 'ing', '-ed', '-er', '-est' and '-y' onto words ending in 'e' with a consonant before it. The 'e' is taken off when you add any of these word endings.

Using the matrix below, make as many words as you can. Check each one is a real word and put it into a sentence orally. If you are unsure, check using a dictionary.

Remember: there are some irregular verbs that do not follow the normal rules. Can you spot them?
