Nursery	Nursery: Nursery RE is non-statutory, but aspects of the RE curriculum are incorporated into children's activities and provide building blocks for later learning eg. celebrating significant festivals: Harvest, Diwali, Christmas, Easter, Eid as well as family events such as birthdays and weddings; making and eating festival food; listening to stories associated with special times of year and discussing themes within them, such as kindness and differences; exploring religious artefacts eg. 'soft toy' artefacts from story, wooden Nativity scene; discussing religious pictures eg. The Nativity by Botticelli, videos of places of worship eg. inside St Paul's, listening to religious music – Christmas carols; starting to introduce religious terminology (from story eg. God/Jesus/Nativity); learning about living things and how to look after the world around them – planting bulbs in autumn, seeds in summer, feeding the birds, collecting the leaves, watching our trees change across the year.
