## Phonics

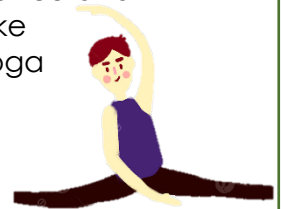
We will continue to use our phonics programme Little Wandle Letters and Sounds to develop our phonetic awareness and develop our reading and writing.

## Physical and Sensory
