

## KS2 SRP Summer Term Newsletter

Hello everyone,

We have approached our final term and as the weather warms up, we look forward to taking part in outdoor learning opportunities. Significant celebrations and events which we will enjoy this term include Eid and World Environment Day (June 5<sup>th</sup>).

We are incredibly proud of our SRP pupils and their progress to date. Most children have shown maturity in managing integration between the SRP and their respective year group classes. This term we plan to further develop our interpersonal skills including group work and shared practical activities. We will also continue to focus on regular handwriting and typing sessions.

In English we will be using colourful semantics to develop comprehension and forming sentence structures. Stories and topics this term include *Rainbow Fish* by Marcus Pfister and *Stuck* by Oliver Jeffers. In Maths we will continue to follow a mastery programme to develop mathematical thinking and during our Maths life skills sessions will review measurements.

### Computing

In Computing the children will look at using computers to make music. This will include listening to music from different genres, making comparisons and create music digitally and non-digitally.

In RE we will learn about Christianity including stories and parables from the bible and elements of Humanism.



### History

As Historians we will continue to learn about Ancient Egypt. We will research who the Egyptians were including how they lived and entertained themselves.



### Geography

We will investigate Jamaica and identify features of a tropical climate whilst also making comparisons with the UK.



### Science

We are looking at living things and their habitats including plants and minibeasts. The children will be explorers and use their investigative skills to identify best materials to build a bug hotel.



### Enrichment

We will continue to visit the local supermarket to procure ingredients to cook and will also make another visit to the local café to develop our independent skills.

We also have a fantastic beach trip planned to Little Hampton and a potential trip to the One O'clock Club in Marble Hill Park.
