

KS2 SRP Spring Term Curriculum Newsletter

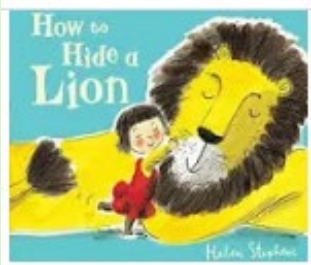
Hello everyone,

Here is what is happening in newton class this term. We continue to use the zones of regulation to check in with how we are feeling each day and also make good use of the OT equipment and calm room within the SRP spaces.

We will continue to integrate with our respective mainstream classes and take part in weekly sensory circuit workouts, spelling, phonics and handwriting practice sessions as appropriate for each child.

English

In English we are kicking off 2026 with 'How to Hide a Lion'. We will also explore stories from Greek mythology to link with our History topic this term on the Ancient Greeks.



Maths

In Maths, we are following the mastering number programme as well as using the NCETM resources. We continue to focus on our understanding of number and use a range of resources to make our learning as practical as possible.

Computing

Some of the children will be accessing the computing curriculum with their mainstream classes. In Newton, we will be developing our keyboard skills in order to record our learning and practise our touch-typing.

RE

This term our focus is on stories from the Bible, including the significance of Easter and why this is celebrated.



History

As historians, we will be learning about Ancient Greece. We will explore who they were and when they lived. We look at why Gods and Goddesses were important and what was a Greek myth.



Geography

After half term, we will be developing our map skills and learning about our local area.



Science

As scientists we are learning about forces. We will learn about pushes and pulls and forces such as friction and gravity. We will explore how magnets work and materials that are magnetic. We will find out about Isaac **NEWTON!!!**

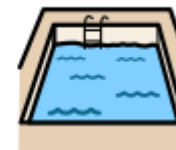


Enrichment
